Non-Binding Review of Civil Taxing Unit Budgets 2013

The meeting of the Elkhart County Council was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Council President John K Letherman. The meeting was held in Room 104 of the County Administrative Building, Goshen, Indiana. Members present were John K. Letherman, Dennis E. Sharkey, Darryl J. Riegsecker, David L. Hess, Randall D. Yohn and David E Foutz.

Also present were Pauline E. Graff, County Auditor; Dawn R. Truex, First Deputy Auditor and Tom Byers, County Administrator.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF NON-BINDING BUDGETS FOR 2013

Todd Samuelson of H.J. Umbaugh and Associates presented a Comparison of Budgets and Levies for County Non-Binding Review. This analysis included Elkhart County, Townships, Cities and Towns, Libraries and New Paris Conservancy District.

On motion made by Sharkey seconded by Riegsecker and unanimously carried, the Council approved the non-binding budgets as presented, with no specific recommendation other than to maintain spending controls to the best of their ability.

On motion made by Foutz and seconded by Hess, Council President Letherman opened the Public Hearing to those in the audience.

BINDING REVIEW OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT:

Tim Neese explained his budget to the Council.

On motion made by Hess, seconded by Riegsecker and unanimously carried, the council approved the Solid Waste Management District's budget.
