ELKHART COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

June 25, 2018

President Mike Yoder called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the County Administration Building, 117 North Second Street, Goshen, Indiana. The other (2) Board members, Frank Lucchese and Suzie Weirick were also present. Others present were Dawn Truex, Auditor's Office; Craig Buche, County Attorney; Tom Byers, County Administrator and Anita Mock, Executive Assistant.

On a motion made by Frank Lucchese, seconded by Suzie Weirick and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Allowance of Claims, as presented by the County Auditor's office.

BUSINESS ITEMS:

Planning & Development Director, Chris Godlewski, requested approval of the closeout for the Lilac Street C & E Excavating Contract. On motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Frank Lucchese and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request.

County Highway Manager of Transportation, Jeff Taylor, requested Commissioners support County Highways action requesting residents to remove boulders from the right of way on County Road 4. On motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Frank Lucchese and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request.

County Highway Manager of Transportation, Jeff Taylor, requested approval to send a letter to residents in the area of County Road 7 and County Road 52 requesting residents not dump grass clippings in the ditch across the roadway. The ditch is going to have to be dug out. On motion made by Frank Lucchese, seconded by Suzie Weirick and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request.

Commissioner Yoder requested to lower the speed limit in the school zone on County Road 37 south of State Road 120 due to County Road 35 being closed while bridge is under construction. There is an Amish school in this area.
